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Dear 18th Annual Cruisin' For A Cure Participant -- **PLEASE READ:**

Thank you for participating in our 18th Annual Cruisin' for A Cure to be held on **Saturday, Sept. 23rd 2017, at the OCFair & Event Center in Costa Mesa.** You are part of what is the largest one-day charity and save your life car show in the country! To assist you in your arrival and throughout the day, over 80 volunteers have committed to work this **MUST SEE EVENT.**

1. You have been issued 2 **TICKET MASTER** tickets that you must turn in when you drive your car in or walk in on Sat. All extra persons in the car must have purchased an individual ticket. Kids under 12 are free. You will need to get your hand stamped if you want to leave and come back. You **CAN** exit at any time during the day.
2. **Indoor Parking:** If you are one of the participants that have reserved parking inside Buildings 12 (Huntington Beach Bldg.), or Bldg. 14.(Los Alamitos Bldg.), Cars for Sale, or Exotic Display, you must arrive on **Friday Sept. 22nd between 8:00 AM and 4:30 PM—No Exceptions.** Meguiar's must be in by 1:30, or let Rick Abate know if you will be late.
 - The Meguiar's Hangar Bldg., Building 12, Building 14 (Gilson), Cars for Sale, and Exotics cards **MUST** be displayed on the windshield & check in at **Gate 5 on Friday, Sept. 22nd. You may not park outside the buildings with these cards.**
 - **Car MUST have less than 5 gallons of gas and the battery disconnected-per Fire Marshall.**
 - You will not be able to remove the car until 3:00 PM Saturday afternoon. The buildings are secured, locked, and patrolled.

Outdoor Parking: On Saturday, the gates open promptly at 4:30AM.

- Please have your entry card displayed & filled out and/or blue Survivor, or pink ladies card prominently on the windshield.
- Each person in the car must have a Ticketmaster ticket prior to entry.
- With 2500+ vehicles arriving, expect some delay getting into the grounds.
- You may enter off the posted Fairview or Arlington entrances. Please follow the signs & Event Staff directions.

Parking Areas: If you plan to arrive as a club and park together, we will try our best to accommodate you. However, it is imperative that your club or group arrive together. It is your option to park with them. Inform the parking staff when you enter the show area so they can direct you to the proper area.

3. **Prostate Cancer Survivors:** If you registered as a survivor, you have a **Blue Survivor Card** for your windshield card, this will alert the judges that you are in the running for the "Best Survivor's Vehicle" award as well. **Please wear your blue "Survivor" shirt to the show and come to the Stage at 1:20 p.m. for a group "Survivor" photo.** We would love to have all the Survivors there - please be patient as lots of photos are taken! **PHOTO WILL BE TAKEN AT 1:30 sharp.**
4. **Event T-Shirts:** If you paid for a T-Shirt in advance, enclosed is a pre-paid form with the size ordered in your envelope. Take this to the Information Booth **INSIDE** the HANGAR building to retrieve your pre-paid shirt(s) from 5:30 AM to 11 AM.
5. **Goody Bags:** If you are one of the first 1,500 pre-registered, you will have a "**Goody Bag**" **TICKET MASTER TICKET**, you may pick up your goody bag at the Information Center/Meguiar's Hangar bldg. from 5:30 AM -11:00 AM Saturday.
6. **Pre-Registered Only! Chance to Win a Set of Budnik Wheels.** Be sure **TO PUT YOUR NAME, CELL NUMBER (with AREA CODE), and EMAIL.** Please take the ticket to the Budnik Wheel display located outside of Building 10 (Costa Mesa Bldg.) on the cruise route. **The winner must be present at the Stage during the awards which start at 3:00 pm promptly.**

THE PROSTATE CANCER TESTING AREA WILL BE OPEN FROM 6:00 A.M. TO 3:30 P.M. FOR ANY MAN 40 AND OLDER. PLEASE TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE FREE SCREENINGS AND HELP US SAVE A LIFE – IT COULD BE YOURS!
